Allegheny River Public Access & Recreation Plan

The City of Olean and its partners – City of Salamanca; Towns of Allegany, Portville, Olean, Salamanca, Carrollton and Villages of Portville and Allegany – need your help establishing a plan for a multi-use recreational trail system along the Allegheny River. The goal of the project is to explore opportunities to improve waterfront access, promote the underutilized river corridor, and attract recreation-based businesses to strengthen the local economy.

You are invited to attend a community workshop on ***Wednesday, October 12, 2016 from 5 – 7 PM in Room 206 of the Manufacturing Technology Institute Building on the JCC Campus, 260 N. Union St., Olean, NY*** to learn how you can be involved and express your input on the project.

The purpose of the meeting will be to provide an overview of the project, share data regarding existing conditions, and discuss the next steps. The meeting is also intended to be a visioning session. Following a brief presentation, the public will have an opportunity to discuss the issues and opportunities that need to be considered and how strategic changes could improve the river corridor.

The meeting is open to the public.
