1. PL#67-10: (Jones) to place flashing school speed limit signs on Washington St at Washington West Elementary School
2. PL#68-10: (Capitani) to place flashing school speed limit signs on W Henley St at Ivers J. Norton Elementary School
3. PL#71-10: (Jones) to amend the Code of Ordinances, Traffic, Section 24-81(b), that the speed limit on E Spring St is 15 miles per hour and a sign to this effect shall be installed at the eastern property line of 500 E Spring St.
4. PL#69-10: (Finch & Jones) amendment to the Code of Ordinance, Section 24-135, Traffic, to prohibit parking and install “No Parking Here to Corner” signs on the southeast corner of Putnam St 15’ West from its intersection with North 11th St and on the southwest corner of Putnam St 15’ East from its intersection with North 12th St
5. PL#70-10: (Finch & Jones) amendment to the Code of Ordinance, Section 24-134, Traffic, to prohibit parking and install “No Parking” signs on the North side of Putnam St from its intersection with North 11th St to its intersection with North 12th St
6. PL#73-10: (Capitani) amendment to the Code of Ordinance, Section 24-134, Traffic, to prohibit parking and install “No Parking Anytime” signs on the south side of York St from its intersection with Monroe Ter to its intersection with Vermont St

7. PL#74-10: (Capitani) amendment to the Code of Ordinance, Section 24-135, Traffic, to prohibit parking and install “No Parking Here to Corner” signs on both the North and South corners of E Ohio St for a distance of 20’ east from its intersection with York St
8. PL#77-10: (Witte) to transfer \$5,147.56 from Contingency to CF #29 to cover the City's share of costs to pave Main Street. Additional funding is necessary to pave Main Street an additional length up to Front Street. Resolution #29-10 previously approved funding for paving from Delevan Ave. to beyond Oviatt St
