The City of Olean and its partners (the City of Salamanca; Towns of Allegany, Portville, Olean, Salamanca, Carrollton and Villages of Portville and Allegany) are pleased to invite members of the community to participate in creating a plan for a multi-use recreational trail system along the Allegheny River. The goal of the project is to identify opportunities to improve waterfront access, promote the underutilized river corridor, and attract recreation-based businesses to strengthen the local economy.

You are invited to attend a community open house on ***Thursday, June 15, 2017 from 6:00 to 8:00 pm in Room 206 of the Manufacturing Technology Institute Building on the JCC Campus, 260 N. Union St., Olean, NY.***

The purpose of the open house is to share initial findings and review recommendations, including a draft vision statement and goals, potential trail alignment options, and possible water access points. Community members are welcome to drop in anytime between 6:00 and 8:00 pm to review project information, meet the project team, and provide feedback. There will not be a formal presentation.

The meeting is open to the public.
