PUBLIC COMMENT/INPUT

Alderman Witte wished Alderman Andreano a Happy Anniversary.

Kevin Bartholomew of 757 Bishop Street decided that he wanted to speak about the legalization of the marijuana. He thinks that with the pending legalization of marijuana the City should allow it to be sold and manufactured in Olean. He thinks

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the opposing members should look at the economic benefits. He said that he has heard that it is a gateway drug. But in his experience it is only a gateway to the refrigerator. He thinks many people have smoked it in the past including him. But that doesn't mean that marijuana use will lead to heroine or crystal meth addiction. He said only people with addicting personalities will get addicted. He said that he had a prescription to [inaudible]. He started with 21 pills, he has 17 left. He only used them for an emergency. In describing addiction he said that some people are addicted to alcohol. He likes beer but not shots. Some people are addicted to shopping, to porn, he evens knows people who are addicted to church. He thinks that legalization of marijuana should be looked it, what the economic benefits are, how it will free up the court system and the police department. Personally he does not do it. But people from 80 to 18 do use it. He was against the laws on smoking, even though he doesn't smoke. He said that people have to be responsible for their own actions. You cannot legislate good behavior or against bad behavior. He thinks marijuana would be good for the Olean, because if Olean doesn't legalize it Portville or Allegany will and the tax money will go to those communities.

TO AUTHORIZE THE SUBDIVISION OF A PARCEL LOCATED AT 1404 BUFFALO STREET IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE III OF THE CITY OF OLEAN CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, an application has been made pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 22, Article III of the City of Olean Code of Ordinances for the approval of a Final Plat of Subdivision to subdivide one lot into three lots associated with the construction of a hotel and further future development of lands owned by HK Olean Hotel, LLC, located at 1404 Buffalo Street; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has received a short Environmental Assessment Form ("EAF") for the project with Part I completed by the applicant; and

WHEREAS, the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) regulations found at 6 NYCRR Part 617.3(a) require that no agency shall carry out, fund, or approve an action until it has complied with the requirements of SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, 6 NYCRR 617.6(a) requires that when an agency receives an application for approval of an action it must: (1) determine whether the action is subject to SEQRA, (2) determine whether the action involves a federal agency, (3) determine whether other agencies are involved, (4) make a preliminary classification of the action, (5) determine whether a short or full EAF will be used to determine the significance of the action, and (6) determine whether the action is located in an Agricultural District; and

WHEREAS, the SEQR regulations indicate at 6 NYCRR 617(b)(4) indicate that for uncoordinated review of an Unlisted Action the agency conducting the review may proceed as if it were the only involved agency; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has independently considered the information provided in the EAF; and

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WHEREAS, the Common Council hereby determines that: (1) the proposed action constitutes an action that is subject to SEQRA; (2) the proposed action is appropriately classified as an Unlisted Action; and (3) a short EAF is adequate for determining the significance of the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council hereby declares that it is Lead Agency with respect to SEQRA review of the proposed subdivision; and

WHEREAS, based on its review of the project, the EAF, and comparison with the Criteria for Determining Significance found at 5 NYCRR Part 617.7(c), the Common Council hereby finds that approval of the HK Olean Hotel, LLC subdivision constitutes an action which will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and, therefore, does not require preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement; and

WHEREAS, the Council's determination of significance shall declare a Negative Declaration made pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law; and

WHEREAS, the Olean Common Council has thoroughly reviewed the preliminary plat for the HK Olean Hotel, LLC Subdivision as submitted to divide an approximately 5.8 acre parcel into three parcels consisting of approximately 2.38 acres, approximately 1.56 acres, and approximately 1.88 acres; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council, upon review, has found that the requested subdivision complies with all City of Olean Zoning requirements; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on Tuesday, February 12, 2019 at 6:15 p.m. after notice as required by Section 22-42, subparagraph (f) of the City of Olean Code of Ordinances, comments of which the Common Council has taken into consideration while determining the appropriate course of action;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Olean that the Final Plat of the Subdivision of lands owned by HK Olean Hotel, LLC, located at 1404 Buffalo Street, Olean, is hereby approved, subject to the condition that the Final Plat of Subdivision substantially conform to the Preliminary Plat of Subdivision prepared by D. Michael Canada as submitted to the Common Council on January 3, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, the contract and associated payment for the bus are conditioned upon the vendor Matthews Bus Alliance d/b/a Matthews Buses Commercial complying with the terms and conditions of the Olean Provider Agreement;

RESOLUTION ORDERING REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES LOCATED AT: 329 NORTH FIFTH STREET, CITY OF OLEAN; TAX MAP ID # 94.056-8-29

WHEREAS, in accordance with Olean City Code Section 6-240 the Fire Chief has filed his report in writing with the Common Council containing his findings and recommendations regarding certain structures situate on the premises located at 329 North Fifth Street, City of Olean; Tax Map ID # 94.056-8-29; which report states his opinion that said structures are unsafe, dangerous, and a nuisance to the public and recommends their immediate removal; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council pursuant to the powers granted to it pursuant to Chapter 6, Article V, Section 240 of the Olean City Code and after (1) reviewing said report; (2) after hearing testimony from the Fire Chief in regard thereto; and (3) after having duly deliberated upon the merits of the matter, have determined that the structures on the premises warrant removal,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that: (1) the record owner of the premises is given thirty days from the date of this Resolution to demolish the building(s) located on the premises at 329 North Fifth Street, City of Olean; Tax Map ID #94.056-8-29, (2) if demolition does not occur prior to the expiration of the thirty day period, the Fire Chief is directed to cause the structures on the premises located at 329 North Fifth Street, City of Olean; Tax Map ID #94.056-8-29 to be immediately demolished; (2) That the record reflects that on November 21, 2019, Code Enforcement Officer Edward Jennings served an order to remedy on Everything is Awesome, LLC, 823 Oneonta Drive, Los Angeles,

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California, 90065, the property owner of record; (3) That the order to remedy or demolish the property at the records owners own expense was to have occurred within 30 days of the service of the owner and to date no action to remedy or demolish has been taken by the record owner; (4) (a) the costs of such demolition shall be charged as an expense against the land on which such building or structure is located secured by a lien filing in the office of the Cattaraugus County Clerk in the amount of the demolition, and (b) the City may commence a special proceeding to collect the costs of said demolition including reasonable and necessary legal expenses incidental to this order to demolish pursuant to New York State General Municipal Law Section 78-b.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Olean is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation for the Allegany River Wastewater Syphon Study and any and all other contracts, documents, and instruments necessary to bring about the project and to fulfill the City of Olean's obligations under the Grant Agreement.

TO AWARD THE THREE DOWNTOWN FARMERS' MARKET PROJECT CONTRACTS TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER

WHEREAS, the Common Council desires to undertake the construction of a new Downtown Farmers' Market structure in Lincoln Park. The structures include an open air market arcade wings and a central seasonal restroom facility and a bistro; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olean has received assistance in the amount of \$600,000 from Senator Catharine Young; \$220,000 from Empire State Development; and \$200,000 from Cattaraugus County; the City of Olean will provide \$230,000 to the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olean requested bids for the general construction, electrical and plumbing for the Downtown Farmers' Market structure and restrooms at Lincoln Park; and

WHEREAS, upon full review of said bids, the City is desirous of awarding the three Downtown Farmers' Market contracts to the lowest responsible bidders; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council awards the three Downtown Farmers' Market contracts to:

General Contract to Kinley Corporation, for an amount not to exceed \$930,805 to include add alternates No. 1 and 2;

Plumbing contract to Ciancio Plumbing for an amount not to exceed \$28,842; and

Electrical contract to Kel-Kur Electric for an amount not to exceed \$102,010, to include add alternates No.1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign any pertinent contracts, documents and instruments associated with the aforementioned Project, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.

RESOLVED, that this Resolution is effective immediately.

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ROLL CALL, AYES ALL EXCEPT ALDERMAN CRAWFORD WHO VOTED NO. MOTIONED CARRIED (6-1)

Alderman Crawford read a prepared statement prior to his personal vote. He said that he believes in the project but has spoken to many people who are against the location of the Farmers' Market. He therefore, as representative of his ward, is voting with respect to his constituents' voice. He said that he received 10-15 calls over the past day and two-thirds of his callers were against the location of the project and in light of that he is voting no.
