

## PUBLIC SAFETY

### 1. Roll Call

Alderman Andreano called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and asked that the record show that all committee members were present.

### 2. Approval of Minutes of the Previous Committee Meeting (Tuesday, March 20, 2018)

A motion to approve the minutes of the March 20, 2018 meeting was made by Alderman Andreano, seconded by Alderman Crawford. Voice vote, ayes all. Motion carried.

### 4. New Referrals for Consideration

- a. PL #44-18: (Crawford) To amend the City of Olean Code of Ordinances Section 24-135 to prohibit parking and install “No Parking Here to Corner” signs on the east side of North Tenth Street for a distance of approximately 55 feet from its intersection with Wayne Street.

Alderman Crawford stated that it was brought to his attention that, on the street next to the YMCA, people are parking between the exit to the YMCA’s parking lot and the intersection. Although it should be common sense not to, people park right in front of the STOP sign on North 10<sup>th</sup> Street at its intersection with Wayne Street. This creates quite a situation. He feels that it would be beneficial to the YMCA and to the area to install the sign.

Mayor Aiello agreed that it is a good move. Alderman Gonzalez stated that he feels that there should be no parking on at least one side of the street, or possibly both. Alderman Crawford stated that he believes that one side of the street is no parking for the entire block.

A motion to approve PL #44-18 was made by Alderman Crawford, seconded by Alderman George. Voice vote, ayes all. Motion carried. Referred to Regular Meeting Tuesday, May 22, 2018 for Resolution.

b. Discussion – Yield Sign, East Ohio Street

Alderman Gonzalez stated that this is the area with a triangle patch of grass between intersecting roads off of East Riverside Drive. When people come to the end of East Ohio Street to turn onto East Riverside Drive, they should yield; however, they often do not. It creates a public safety issue.

Mr. Ring added that a resident brought this concern to his attention. A City Engineer many years ago designed several low volume intersections with no signage, which he feels is poor judgment. He asks that the Council come to him with any similar concerns on other streets.

A PL and Resolution will be introduced at the next Regular Meeting.

5. Approval of Committee Reports

A motion to approve committee reports was made by Alderman Andreano, seconded by Alderman Dougherty. Voice vote, ayes all. Motion carried.

6. Adjournment
