

## PUBLIC SAFETY

### 1. Roll Call

Alderman Robinson called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and asked that the record show that all Aldermen were present except Alderman Gonzalez, who was excused.

### 4. New Referrals for Consideration

#### i. Discussion – No Parking, Reed Street at North 12<sup>th</sup> Street

Alderman Robinson explained that he would like to have the “No Parking Here to Corner” signs on Reed Street at its intersection with North 12<sup>th</sup> Street moved approximately 10 to 15 feet and provided photos for the Aldermen. He explained that when people park near the corner at the sign, vehicles have to pull up in the middle of the street at the intersection and there are issues getting around the corner. He explained that he has spoken with Mr. Ring and Chief Richardson and they agree that this change is needed. He explained that he would like the sign moved to the opposite side of the driveway in the photo.

Alderman Witte explained that she feels that this is a great idea. Alderman Crawford asked if anyone has spoken with the resident who lives in this corner house. Alderman Robinson explained that they are not okay with the change, but they will be fine since they have the driveway. He explained that he did let them know that they could attend a meeting to voice their opinions. He explained that as he has driven by in the past few days he has noticed that

they are already parking back farther. Alderman Crawford asked if this concern was voiced by another neighbor, and Alderman Robinson responded that it was.
